The regular season wrapped up on Saturday, Feb. 3, and when the day's final duals were complete, a three-way tie developed in the WDA standings for second place among Williston, Dickinson, and Century. All finished 8-2 and behind WDA regular season champion Bismarck High. Based on a three-team tie-break and of which of the tied teams has the most individual matches won against the other two, Williston wins the tie-break and earns the No. 2 seed at the upcoming Class A state dual. Dickinson is the No. 3 seed while Century is No. 4 based on its head-to-head outcome. Next week, wrestlers head to Minot for the West Region Individual Tournament
